2015 was a year with few hot summer days; heatwaves tended to last for a day or two but the highest temperature was the highest for 9 years. April ( 222 h ) was almost the sunniest month of the year (June was sunnier with $\mathbf{2 2 4} \mathrm{h}$ ). As a result there were relatively few sunny days during the year - while in November just 25 h of sunshine were recorded. December (with no air frosts) was warmer than November and both were only slightly colder than October. 2015 was slightly drier than average, with March, April and June being quite dry. 2015 had the wettest day for four years, and the first snow for two years - but very few thunderstorms.
